This past school year has been one marked with resilience, growth and determination. I want to share my sincere thanks for your unwavering and continued support of the education of our students in Bloom Township District 206. We were able to have an in person graduation in our Sarff Field for the first time in district history. Special congratulations to the entire Class of 2021. It always gives me great joy to see another class successfully complete the necessary graduation requirements to help actualize their future goals.

I am excited to see that in May of 2021, the Illinois State Board of Education passed a resolution to resume fully in-person learning for all student attendance days for school year 2021-2022. Remote instruction is only available for students who are not eligible for a COVID-19 vaccine **and** are under a quarantine order by a local public health department or the Illinois Department of Public Health. Vaccines are now widely available to all Illinoisans age 12 and older. We will continue to follow the recommendation by the CDC (Centers for Disease Control and Prevention) that masks be worn within school buildings until further notice.

I have partnered with Jewel-Osco and Howard Brown Health to bring an onsite vaccination clinic to both Bloom and Bloom Trail High Schools. Notifications have been sent to all households. If you or your student did not participate in the first clinic at Bloom High School, we are offering the first dose of the Pfizer vaccine at Bloom Trail High School this Friday, June 4th. The hours are 10:00am – 12:00pm and 1:00pm – 3:00pm. You can register at this link. <https://hbh-covid-vaccine.as.me/Bloom> Walk-ins are welcome, but we encourage you to register ahead of time.

We will continue to provide breakfast and lunch to students throughout the summer. Please reference the meal distribution list on our website. Students who are participating in our summer school program will receive a grab and go meal. You will receive another letter from me as we approach the new school year. Continue to stay safe and have a restful summer.
