Bloom Township District 206 Faculty, Staff, Students, and Community,

Governor Pritzker has announced the following:

“I’m gratified that the Supreme Court vacated the lower court’s restraining order, meaning that if a school mask mandate needs to go into effect in the future, we continue to have that authority.”

“I’m also extremely pleased to say that because the CDC has recommended that masks are needed only in areas of high transmission, the State of Illinois will move forward to remove our school mask mandate, effective Monday. We will recommend that all school districts follow CDC guidance and will update our existing guidance in the coming days.”

Masks are optional for Bloom Township District 206’s students, staff, and visitors starting Monday, February 28, 2022. Although masks will not be required, some may choose to continue to wear a mask. We ask for continued understanding and kindness for those who may choose to continue to wear a mask.

Thank you for your flexibility as we work to align our district procedures to the guidance issued by Governor Pritzker and the CDC.
