

BREAKFAST AND A SNACK SERVED DURING SUMMER FOR ALL CHILDREN

Bloom Township High School District 206 will participate in a summer breakfast and snack program through the NSLP Seamless Summer Option (SSO). A free breakfast and a snack, which meet federal guidelines, will be made available to students in District 206 summer programs and to all children (18 years of age and under) in the community.

The SSO program will begin on Monday, June 2, 2025 and end on Friday, July 11, 2025. There will be no meals served on Thursday, June 19, 2025 and Friday, July 4, 2025 due to the holidays. Breakfast will be served from 7:30AM – 8:15AM, Monday through Friday and a snack will be served at 10:00AM, Monday through Friday.
