

## District 206 Chromebook Information 2026-2027

- Each District 206 student is issued one district-owned Chromebook.
- Students are expected to bring their Chromebook to school fully charged every school day.
- If a student forgets their Chromebook, they may check out a daily loaner up to five times per semester. Daily loaner Chromebooks must remain in school and be returned by 3:00 PM on the same day it is checked out.
- Students are responsible to maintain and care for their assigned devices to ensure they are in good working order; they must report broken, lost or stolen Chromebooks as soon as possible to the Chromebook service center at their school.
- Students are responsible for any cost to fix a Chromebook or the cost to replace a Chromebook broken beyond repair, lost or stolen.
- If a student leaves the district prior to graduation, the Chromebook must be returned to the District or the student will be charged the replacement cost of the device, power adapter and any missing accessories.
- To be eligible to receive a Chromebook, the student's parent/guardian must review and sign the "District 206 Chromebook Agreement" and "Parental Consent for Student Google Workspace for Education Account" when registering for school. By signing this document, families agree to the guidelines set forth in the agreement. Students using District technology and networks are also subject to the rules and policies outlined in the Student Handbook and the District's Acceptable Use Policy.
- Students are strongly discouraged from bringing personal computers to school. District 206 is not responsible for personal devices that students bring to school. District 206 staff cannot provide technical support, install district software or connect personal devices to the school Wi-Fi.
